



The Raid 100 Entries and Cancellation Policy

Entry Fees

- Early bird: AUD\$1320/person – Payment in full between 13/09/2021 and 31/12/2021.
- Standard: AUD\$1430/person – Payment in full between 01/01/2022 and 04/03/2022.
- Late: AUD\$1540/person – Payment in full between 05/03/2022 and 01/05/2022.

Entry Schedule

6 September 2021	Early bird team entry applications open.
13 September 2021	First round of applications close and offers made to teams for a spot in the race. \$250/person non-refundable deposit required to confirm a place in the race.
31 December 2021	Early bird payment due in full (remaining \$1070/person).
4 March 2022	Standard fee payment due in full (remaining \$1180/person). Entry after this date = \$110/person late fee. Withdrawal prior to this date = full refund less \$250/person deposit.
1 April 2021	Withdrawal between 04/03/22 and 01/04/22 = 50% refund on entry fee.
1 May 2021	Withdrawal from 02/04/22 onwards = no refund.

Entry Applications

Every prior edition for the Rogue Raid in the last 12 years has sold out. As such, we have implemented an entry procedure that ensures entries are obtained in a fair and equitable manner. To alleviate the stress of a first-come first-serve system, entry into the Raid 100 will proceed as follows:

- Teams can apply for an entry between 6-12 September 2021. If there are enough places available in the race for the number of applications, then all teams will be offered a place with subsequent entries on a first come first serve basis.
- If there are more applications than the capacity of the race, entries will be selected on the following criteria in the following order:
 1. Volunteers: Teams with at least one competitor who has volunteered at a QRA or Raid event in the last 24 months will receive a guaranteed entry (more on the volunteer rewards [here](#)).
 2. International teams. That is, at least half the team members are travelling from overseas to compete in the race.
 3. Interstate A1 teams. At least half the team is travelling from outside SEQ/northern NSW AND have competed in two or more Adventure1 races in the past 12 months.
 4. All remaining teams will enter a lottery process.

If the race reaches capacity through the application process, teams will be put on a waitlist. Every effort will be made to get them a place in the race and it should be noted that invariably waitlist teams have almost always been offered a place in the Rogue Raid during the lead up to the race due to other team's withdrawals, etc.



Standard Cancellation Policy Guidelines

- Teams are permitted to exchange any or all members at any point up until a day before the race. Teams are permitted to change team names at any point up until a day before the race. Hence, teams are effectively allowed to personally on-sell their entry (at cost) to another team in the event that they are unable to compete.
- An AUD\$250/person non-refundable deposit is due upon the offer of an entry to confirm a place in the race (that is \$500/team of two or \$1000/team of four). Entry applications open on 6 September 2021 and offers made to teams from 13 September 2021 depending on the number of available places. Entry into the race will only be guaranteed upon receipt of the full team deposit.
- Full payment of early bird entries (that is, the remaining \$1070/person) is due by 31 December 2021. After this point, the full fee of \$1430/person is owing (that is, \$1180 remaining).
- Full standard payment is due by 4 March 2022. Entries or payment received after this point will incur a \$110/person late fee. Note that entries may be closed earlier than this if they reach capacity.
- Teams that cancel an entry prior to COB on 4 March 2022 are entitled to a full refund less their \$250/person deposit. Teams cancelling an entry between 5 March 2022 and 1 April 2022 will receive a 50% refund on entry fee. Teams cancelling an entry after COB 1 April 2022 will not receive a refund.
- In the unlikely event that organisers have to postpone the race, all efforts will be made to reschedule the event and entries transferred to the new date. If teams are unable to attend the new date, a refund will be made of the entry fee paid, less the initial \$250/person deposit.
- In the extremely unlikely scenario where the organisers have to completely cancel the event and can't reschedule, teams will receive a refund on their entry fee less the \$250/person deposit.

Covid Related Team Cancellations

- If a team cannot compete due to a snap Covid lockdown (that is, half or more of the team can't travel due to a border closure or local lockdown) and the race still goes ahead as scheduled, competitors will be refunded their full fees paid less the initial \$250/deposit. Alternatively, they can select to have their full fee credited towards a future Rogue Raid or Raid 100 race.
- Any team placed on a waitlist that is subsequently offered a place in the race will be offered the rate available at the time at which they applied and joined the waitlist.
